Newer BMWs are now equipped with the Auto Start-Stop function. The main purpose of auto Start/Stop is to save fuel. Every time you stop at a red light or are stopped in traffic, the engine turns off. Everything in the car, including the ignition, remains on. As soon as you take your foot off the brake, the engine starts again automatically. It takes about 1 second for the BMW engine to restart.
