Robert Venturi, however, got most of the credit- in 1991, he was awarded the prestigious Pritzker Prize and Denise was left out. Venturi and Scott Brown also went on to practice together — they loved recognizable historical elements of architecture, like gables to indicate houses and columns to signal important buildings like banks.

### **Lessons from Las Vegas - 99% Invisible**

He calls his own design complex and simple, open and closed, the roof is a gable without a gable, a door without an entry, a stair that goes nowhere. This is his idea of the inclusive fragments. His idea of simplicity is described as “the satisfaction the mind derives from inner complexity” (Venturi 18).
